Introduction

It is our school policy that all children wear school uniforms when attending school and when participating in school-organised events outside normal school hours. A complete uniform list is attached and is available to buy from Uniforms4kids in Temple Fortune either in person or online. Uniforms can be delivered free of charge to the school every Thursday morning by Uniform4Kids, if required. However, if any items need to be sent back for exchange or refund, this has to be done by the parent/carer, not the school. We do not take responsibility for any lost orders.

Parents must ensure that their child has the correct uniform and that it is clean, in good repair and clearly marked with their name on. Including swimwear.

Aims and Objectives

Our policy on school uniforms is based on the belief that school uniforms promote a sense of pride in our school. It also

- helps to create a sense of community and belonging towards the school;
- identifies the children with the school;
- supports our commitment to inclusion;
- prevents children from wearing clothes that could be distracting in class;
- is practical, smart and designed with health and safety in mind;

Footwear

For health and safety reasons all children are required to wear plain black/blue leather school shoes or trainers all year round. In addition, please ensure that the shoes have velcro fasteners so children can manage independently. Loose and incorrectly tied shoelaces are hazardous and dangerous.

P.E. Kit

Children from Year 1 and 2 need a change of clothes and footwear for P.E lessons (Fridays) and Football Club on Mondays. A school drawstring bag is required in which to keep the kit at school. The Avenue's PE kit includes:

- A navy-blue drawstring Avenue PE bag
- Blue jogging bottoms or shorts
- Suitable sports trainers

Swimming Kit

All children in Reception, Year 1 and 2 attend Poolside Manor for a weekly swimming class. Children must wear the school navy swimsuit. Bathing hats are required to be worn by Poolside Manor and hats may be purchased either from them or Uniform4kids. Swimwear must be clearly marked also towels (not a uniform item)
